Guidelines for students submitting entries in the category of Computer Graphic Design

1. Submissions in this category may consist of any original visual representation including commercial art (illustrations), page design, litho and/or logos.
2. The work must be original. Teachers, parents and friends may give advice and support but nothing more.
3. All work must have a theme related to ancient Rome or Greece.
4. Entries must be printed. Computer presentations cannot be accommodated.
5. These original works must be done with computer graphics software programs. They may include the use of photos, illustrations, diagrams, stylized text and/or JPEGs or GIFs.
6. A student may make just one entry. It should be no larger than an ordinary piece of computer paper and this should be accompanied by a 3"x5" giving a caption and listing special effects used in its creation. The entry may be mounted on cardboard or displayed in a frame.
7. THE STUDENT'S NAME, SCHOOL NAME, GRADE AND TEACHER'S NAME SHOULD APPEAR ON THE **BACK** OF THE ENTRY OR ITS MOUNTING. THAT INFORMATION MUST NOT BE VISIBLE TO THE JUDGES.
